In the spring of 1978, at the tender age of 27, Max and Sherry left the security of their "real" jobs in California and returned to Texas with only \$40 in the bank. Within 48 hours of mailing their first art newsletter they sold more than \$15,000 worth of paintings and wildlife bronzes. God greatly blessed the work of their hands.

Today they live on a 126-acre Hill Country ranch near Kerrville, in the earth-sheltered home Max designed. Sherry's rule still stands: "If it is named and tamed, it can't be aimed!" The deer now wait patiently for their free buffet.

Their legacy: the **Divine Servant** bronze, the **77-foot Empty Cross**, and **The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden** on I-10.
